- All seven yard waste sites accept leaves, grass, garden waste and [food scraps](#).

- Visit yard waste sites during the week. If you need to go on a weekend, Saturday mornings from 9:15 - 10:30 a.m. can be less busy.

Throughout the season, the following materials will be offered free to residents (when available):

- Wood mulch.
- Compost.
- Fill dirt.
- Woodchips.
